now employed by me, for very little remuneration, the sum
of Two hundred pounds, free of duty. In the event of her
death, before me, I bequeath to her daughter, Pollie Patton,
the sum of One hundred pounds, free of duty.

I bequeath to Frank A. Harris, of Stockton Heath, the sum
of One hundred pounds, free of duty.

I bequeath to Arthur W. J. Harris the sum of One hundred
pounds, free of duty.

I bequeath to Mrs Annie Stubbs, of St Helens, One
hundred pounds, free of duty.

I bequeath to Mrs Jane Smith, of St Helens, One hundred
pounds, free of duty.

I bequeath to Gertrude E. Black, of Sutton, St Helens.
One hundred pounds, free of duty.

I bequeath to my friend Frances Mary Lea, if living at
my death, the sum of One hundred pounds, duty free.

After these bequests have been made, I bequeath all
the rest of my estate and effects, of every description
both real and personal, to be equally divided
between, Carrie Castle of Bristol, and her sister Amy
Stephenson, of Bebington. daughters of my late cousin
Sarah Jane Heap.

I desire that my Executors will very specially thank
Mrs Florence Critchley, of Orchard Cottage Fearnhead
for all her great kindness to me, since my husband's
death.

I desire to be buried in the ~~Warrington~~ Cemetery
in the same grave as my late husband, providing there
is room, and if not with my parents in the
Hillcliffe burying ground.

I appoint Carrie Castle, of Bristol, Alan Herbert Hatton Solicitor, of Warrington, and John Glover, of St Helens, Solicitor, to be my Executors, and direct that all my debts, and funeral expenses, (including doing both the grave at the cemetery and the one at Hill Cleft in a satisfactory manner) be paid as soon as possibly may be after my decease.

I revoke every former will.
