Executor of this my Will I direct my Executor to pay my just debts and  
funeral and Testamentary expenses I give and bequeath to my daughter  
Jane Ann Molyneux such of my household furniture herein named by me  
the same being the chest of drawers corner cupboard and the crockery contained  
therein and the oil painting of her mother's portrait each and all for her  
own use absolutely I give the remainder of my furniture and other  
household effects to my son James Lowe and also to the aforementioned Jane  
Ann Molyneux my daughter to divide each to have an equal share And  
further I give my sons Henry Lowe James Lowe Thomas Lowe and my  
daughter Jane Ann Molyneux each and all an equal share in my  
two houses at Spindle Hillock in North Ashton aforesaid and numbered  
32 and 34 respectively In witness whereof I have to this my last Will set  
my hand this 27<sup>th</sup> day of September 1905 Witness my hand this 27<sup>th</sup> day of  
September 1905

same time who in his presence and the presence of each  
other have hereunto subscribed our names as witnesses
